## Assessments

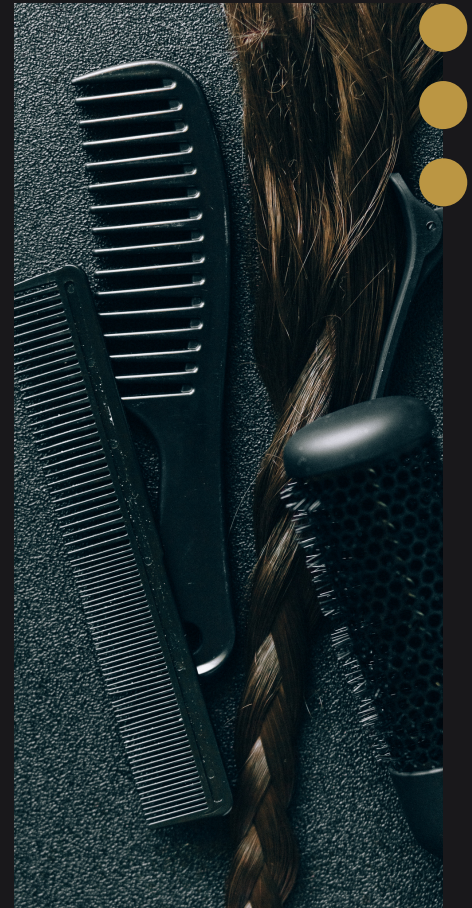
All units are assessed using a variety of the following assessment methods:
